**ACCEPTED MATERIALS INCLUDE:**

- Stain and varnish
- Paint remover and thinner
- Gasoline and kerosene
- Windshield washer solution
- Aerosol cleaners
- Drain and oven cleaners
- Metal polishes and rust removers
- Oil- and lead-based paint
- Ammonia-based cleaners
- Rechargeable batteries
- Petroleum-based adhesives
- Glues, caulk, contact cements and resins
- Fertilizers, pesticides, and weed killers

**ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED INCLUDE:**

- Latex paint\*
- Used motor oil\*
- Used oil filters\*
- Lead acid batteries\*
- Needles\*
- Ammunition
- Explosives
- Asbestos
- Radioactive material
- Fire extinguishers
- Compressed gas cylinders
